Christian Education at First Presbyterian Church

Sunday School

Our Sunday School classes for children PreK-8th grade are built around the curriculum called **Spark: Activate Faith**. Over two years, students learn about key stories from Genesis through Paul's letters. They'll interact with the Bible in every lesson, navigating the stories and beginning to compare what they are learning to their own lives. Lessons around the Bible story are packed with activities, interactive games, and creative crafts.



We'll all begin in worship together and then, around 10:15 AM, all children who wish to participate in Sunday School may head to their classrooms on the first and second floors of the Christian Education wing (the northeast corner of the building) with their classroom shepherd.

Classes end when worship ends and we ask that students through 5th grade are picked up by an authorized person once worship has ended so our teachers and helpers can also take part in social hour with our faith community.

Confirmation

Our confirmation program is designed for students ages 8th grade and up who wish to learn more about what it means to confirm for themselves the promises made at their baptism. We use the Episcopal **Confirm not Conform: Presbyterian Edition** curriculum, a youth confirmation program that exposes youth to a wide range of topics, including Scripture, sacraments, creeds, heresy, prayer, other religions, and serving others, and asks them to think through what they believe and why.



Confirm not Conform emphasizes finding one's own voice rather than simply conforming to an external standard. It is a program that respects the work youth and adults do as they explore their faith, trusting that when people put in the effort to articulate what they believe and why, they will make good choices about their next step in faith.

Classes meet for 17 Sundays throughout the school year. Before the school year begins, we have a weekend retreat and we end the year with an all-church celebration on a Saturday in the weeks leading up to Confirmation, which is typically celebrated on Pentecost. (Because Pentecost is so late in 2026, celebrations will be in May.)

Join other members of your church family after worship on Sunday, November 23, to enjoy a meal and to make an Advent wreath with fresh cuttings to get you ready for the season. If you have been building a crèche set with new pieces yearly, your next piece will also be ready for you. And, if this is all new to you, come get your first piece to join the tradition of building handmade crèche figures for you to take home and use throughout the season.

Third Grade Bible Presentation & Luncheon

On Sunday, January 4, Third Graders will receive a new Bible from the church during worship and then, from 11:15 AM-12:15 PM, come to Fellowship Hall for an interactive lesson on how to find things in their (new) Bibles, why the Bible is significant, and when to turn to it. Fun crafts to help navigate the Bible are part of our time together!

Curious about this font?

Atkinson Hyperlegible Next is part of a family of fonts created and provided free of charge—for personal AND commercial use—by the Braille Institute of America.

They've created a family of hyperlegible® fonts designed to improve legibility and readability for individuals with low vision. These carefully crafted fonts feature clear, highly distinctive letters and numbers that make reading easier and more accessible.

For low-vision readers, certain letters and numbers can be hard to distinguish from one another. The Atkinson Hyperlegible® font uses special design principles to differentiate characters and make each one unique.

- Letters have received special care to ensure they're legible and clear (like B8 O0).
- Similarly-shaped upright letters are distinctly different (like 1Iil).
- Matching letter pairs are clearer and easier to identify (like EF pq).
- Large areas inside letters, called counters, keep characters clear (like ebgs).
- Angled spurs and longer tails help increase differentiation (like gmnr).
- Circular elements reflect the heritage of the Braille Institute (like Å9%.).
